Teen Room Policy

The staff at Wood Library strives to create a safe, respectful, warm, inviting, and fun environment for teens by providing a designated space for them to engage in individual or group activities.

The Teen Room represents the Library's effort to ensure that students in grades 6 through 12 have a place that is safe, relaxing, and responsive to their library needs and interests. Quality library service to teens that reflects their unique informational, educational, and recreational needs is vital, and teens must have access on an equal basis with adults to all the services and materials the Library provides.

The Teen Room is intended for middle school and high school teens during all times when school is not in session, including holidays and school breaks. Other individuals are welcome to use the Teen Room during school hours, 9am-2pm. All patrons using the Teen Room are expected to follow the Library Code of Conduct.

The Library reserves the right to utilize the Teen Room for scheduled teen programs or library events.
